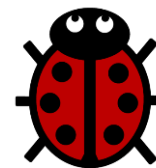


Nursery News

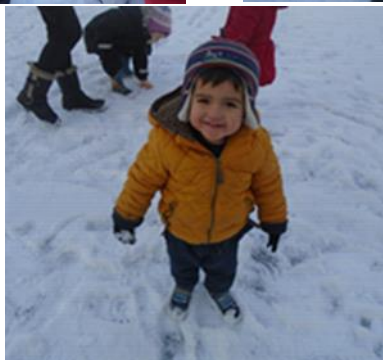


This month we have enjoyed:
